Celebrating the Life of Allen Sadao Yokomoto Jr., born January 21, 1929 in Koloa Kauai, Hawaii. Where he lived until 7 years old. His most important events in his life were the birth of his children, coaching at Kahuku High School and being a University of Hawaii Basketball player.
