Celebrating the Life of Victorina Lorenzo Barut Olipares, born on September 7, 1928 in Bacarra Ilocos, Norte, Philippines; where she lived until 1955. Her parents were Escolastica Castillo and Ciriaco Barut. She was the 4th child of eight children. She attended St. Williams College in Laoag. She earned her Elementary Teaching Certificate; after graduation she began a career as an Elementary School Teacher in the Philippines. She was also a housekeeper for the Outrigger Waikiki & Holiday Inn. She retired in 1990 after serving 23 years. After retirement, she enjoyed traveling and helping with her husband's yard service business. She was married to Micolás Pascua Olipares on November 10, 1954 in Manila.

She was loving, caring, family oriented, organized, happy and full of laughter. One of her most important events in her life was the birth of her three children.
