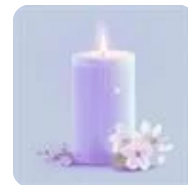
I remember seeing Mama Loling at all the family functions. Her smile was so infectious, and hugs always warm. Gonna miss her beautiful soul.
