Mariano Cachola Jr., 78, of Waipahu, passed away on March 16, 2015. He was born on April 10, 1936 in Vigan City, Ilocos Sur, Philippines, where he lived until 1993. His parents were Mariano M. Cachola Sr. and Roberta Munoz Cachola. He was the 4th child of 7 children. Mariano attended Burgos Memorial School Loest, Immaculate Conception School, Technological University of the Philippines and University of Northern Philippines where he earned a Bachelor of Science in Industrial Education and began his career as Teacher.
