I miss throwing football with you in the yard. I regret all the time I spent running around with others, when it could have been with you. I'm so glad we ended up playing together on the same team. Your last season, your last team. It was fun. We were like the Ringers! Lol. I'll never forget you Lyle. Your always alive if I'm alive. Because you Live in my Heart. You live there forever. I'll see you soon, Bro. I gotta work now, but I could sit here outside my job and write to you for days. I love you. Have a spot on your team ready for me! 3rd base! Lates
