After retirement, she moved back to American Samoa with her husband Florencio and her youngest daughter. She attended New Hope prior to entering Pearl City Nursing home in 2014. Her favorite quote was, "You think you funny, ah!" The most important events in her life were the births of each of her 5 grandchildren, whom she loved dearly. She is described as a strong disciplinarian in love, generous, and selfless. In her younger years, she enjoyed softball, volleyball, sewing and crocheting.

Vai sacrificed her education to help her parents raise her siblings. She moved to Hawaii in her teens, got married, and slowly brought her siblings to Hawaii. She and her husband supported them through school until they moved away to attend colleges on the mainland.
