Ernesto will always be remembered as a protective, strong, and loving man to his family and friends.



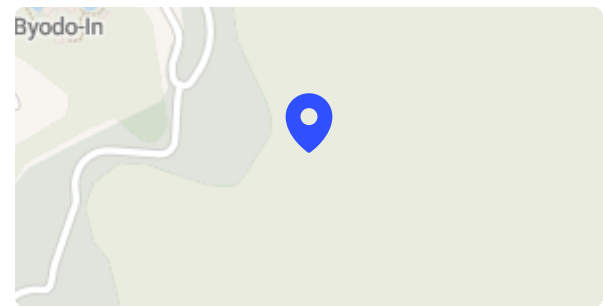
