Committal services will be held at 11:00 a.m. on Thursday, January 5, 2017, at Hawaii State Veterans Cemetery.

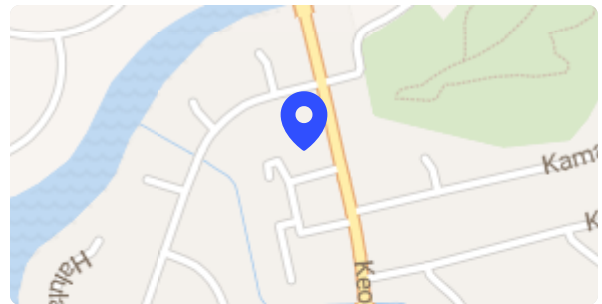

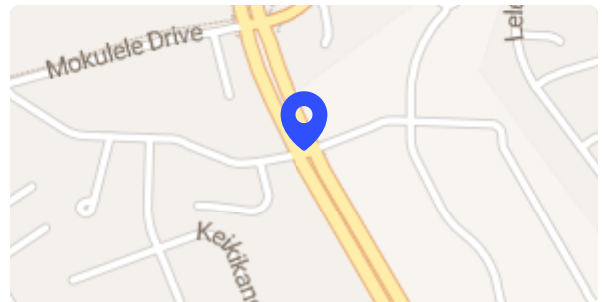

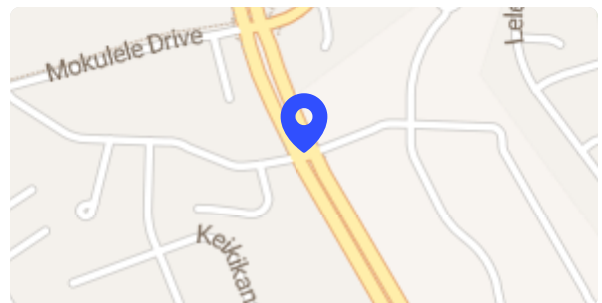
