Juan Guzman Agbayani, 78, of Honolulu, Hawaii has passed away in Honolulu, Hawaii on Tuesday, July 11, 2017. He was born to Hilaria (Guzman) and Claudio Yagin Agbayani in Barrio Barikir, Sinit, Ilocos Sur, Philippines on May 7, 1939. He was the second eldest of six children.

He retired as a construction carpenter, after serving 26 years of service. After retirement, he assisted in his wife's care home business.
