James Yoshimitsu Makio, 85, of Kailua, Oahu, passed away peacefully on Tuesday, February 13, 2018, at his residence. 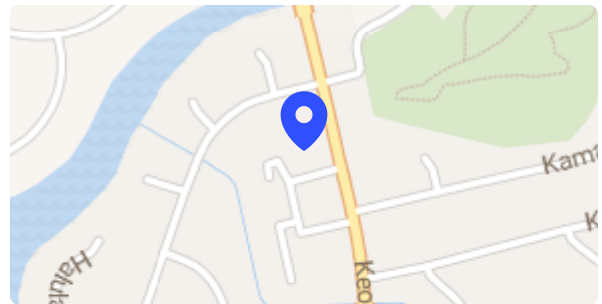

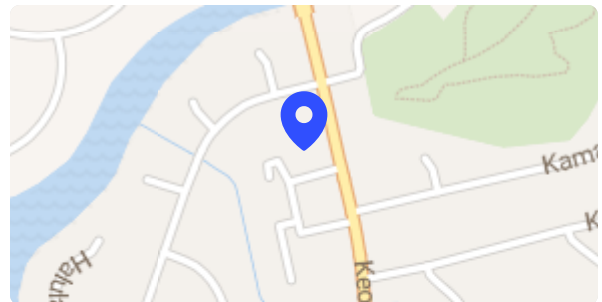

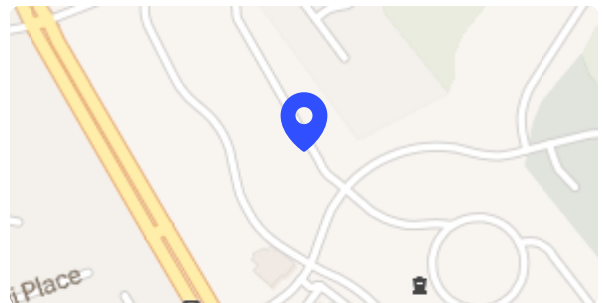
