You will be truly missed by all. Always in our hearts. #Flying with Angels.



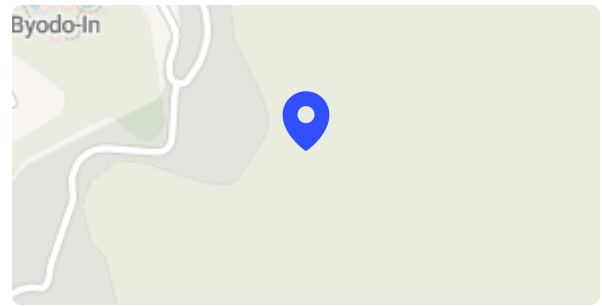
