From Carpentry to geology, investing to farming, physics to history, opera to traveling, his many interests kept him young at heart. He is survived by three Daughters and one son, Mary Jane Field Riford (Lloyd Stephen III) of O'ahu, Sylvia Jean Field James (Frank William) of Las Vegas, Peter Robert Field (Karen Ruth Wiegardt) of O'ahu and Linda Elisabeth Field Sisson (Jeffrey Alan) of Arkansas.
