Maria Dolores Sagadraca Bolosan was born in Cadaratan, Bacarra, Ilocos Norte, Philippines on June 12, 1931 as the eldest child and daughter of Lorenzo and Justa Ramiro Sagadraca. After her naturalization as an American Citizen, she removed her first name, Maria.

In October 1948, Maria Dolores married a handsome and dashing American citizen, Hospicio Cacal Bolosan. Arriving as a lovely young bride, “Loling” came to love and live in the Territory of Hawaii where she raised her family.

She will be remembered for her culinary skills in her humble kitchen at home.

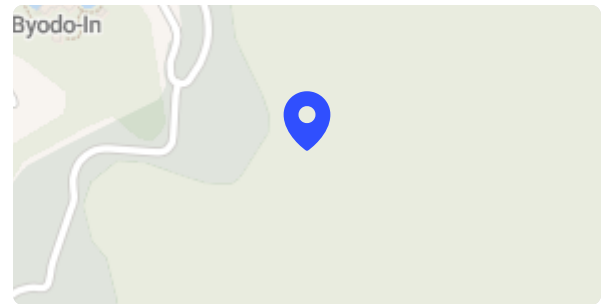

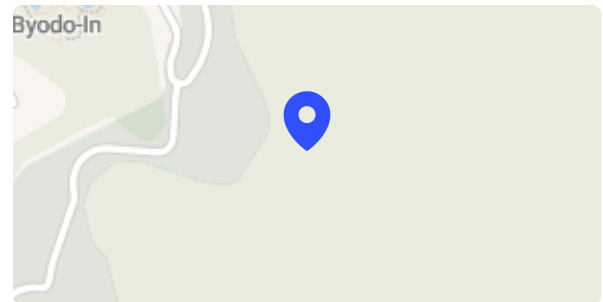

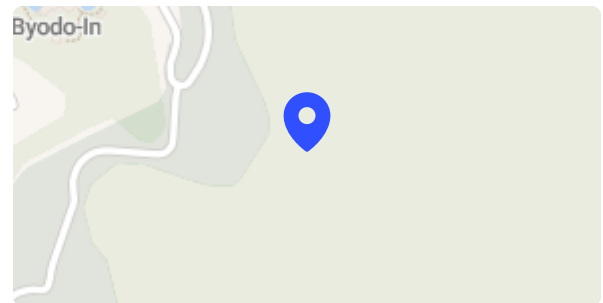
