Services will be held on November 17, 2023 from 9am -11:30am at St. Philomena Catholic Church. Burial to follow at Valley of the Temples Memorial Park.



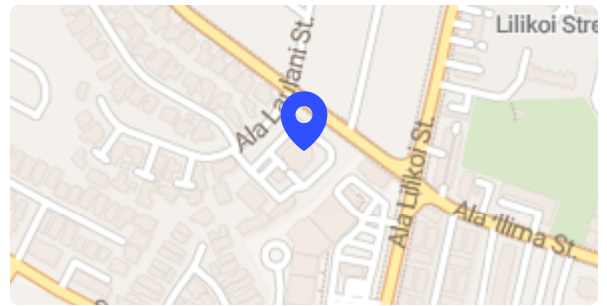

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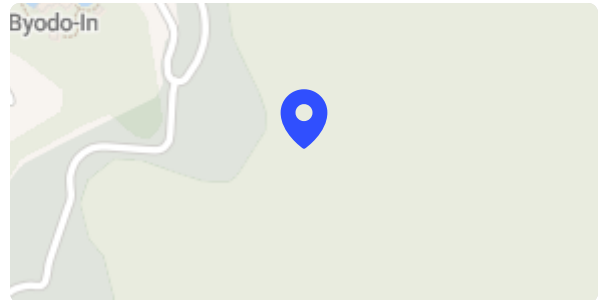
