Rest in aloha, Lorraine.



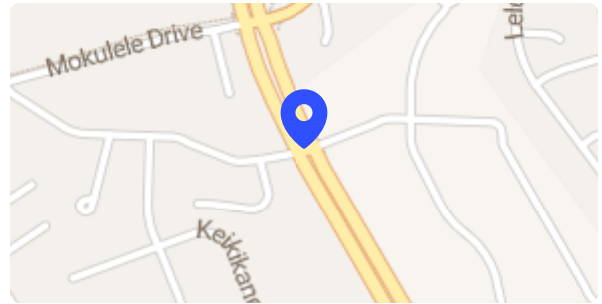
