Nana made awesome desserts like choc chip marshmallow choc cake, pineapple upside down cake, or key lime pie. We spent much of the summer months & weekends at Kuhio Beach. We were just kids with our homemade paipo boards & towel, walking 3.5 miles to the beach. Sometimes, Papa would drop us off, before work, & pick us up, after. Other times, Papa would return home to pickup Nana & the meal she had prepared for us. We'd end a beautiful day, with a picnic at the beach, or Kapiolani Park.

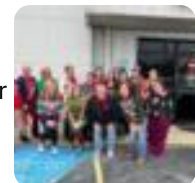

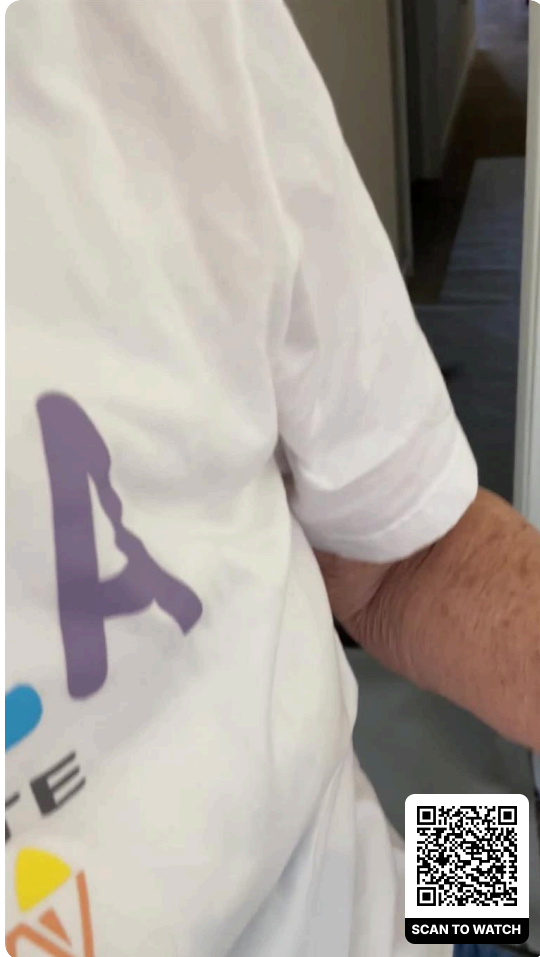
