May he rest in peace.






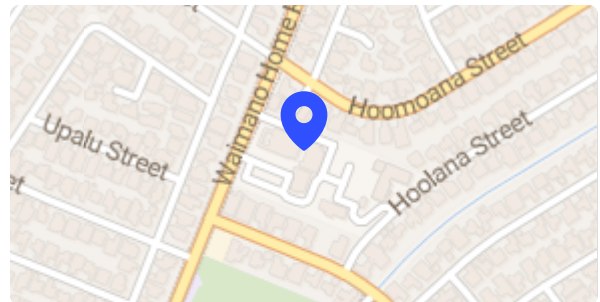
