It is with great sadness that we announce the passing of Katsue Yamazaki (Johnson) Hiraki on March 11, 2025, age 89, at her daughter's home in Kailua, Hawaii. It was here she found joy in her final years, observing the Hawaiian flora and fauna and basking in the warmth of the Hawaiian climate. Katsue was born February 20, 1936 in Ibaraki-ken, Japan. With her husband, Albert Johnson, she moved to Hawaii in 1959. The family relocated to Anchorage, Alaska in 1969 where Katsue worked at Duty Free Shoppers from 1972 until her retirement in 1991. 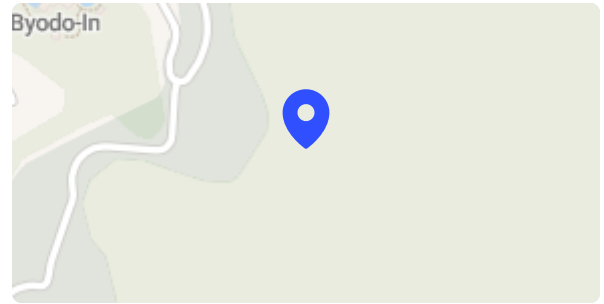
