## Jettie Silva

APR 22, 1940 - JUN 14, 2025

**J**ettie Mae Silva, a longtime resident of Kāneʻohe, Hawaiʻi, passed away peacefully at home on June 14, 2025, surrounded by her loving family. She was 85 years old and had bravely and gracefully fought a five-year battle with cancer.

She is survived by her three daughters: Alice Yasumura, Teresa (Nate) Ubando, and Jettie (Chris) Silva-Chojnowski; her daughter-in-law, Thelma Silva; six grandchildren: Malia, Julice (Scott), Alex, Kawika (Ellen), Josiah (Jaz), and Lopaka (Jaz); and seven great-grandchildren: James, Zoey, Taylee, Nohea, Kaimana, Brady, and Keanu—with one more expected soon.

Jettie was preceded in death by her beloved husband, Robert Novite Silva; her son, Robert Novite Silva Jr.; her grandson, Logan Silva; her daughter, Julice Silva; her brother, Jim; her sister, Ina; and her parents, James and Julia Howell.

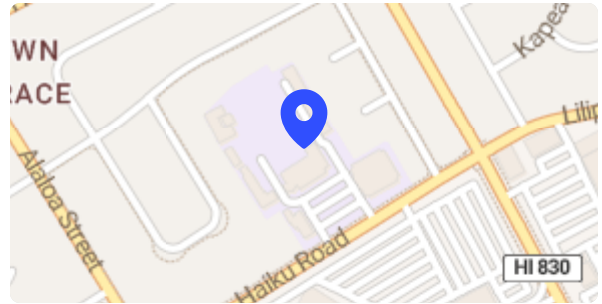

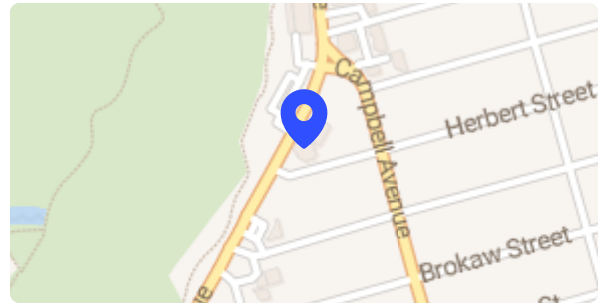

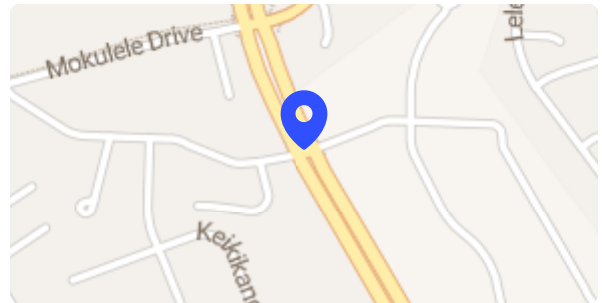
