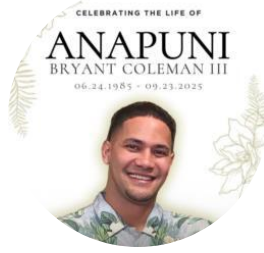

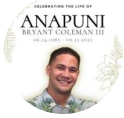
# **ANAPUNI B. COLEMAN III**

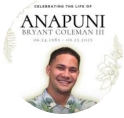

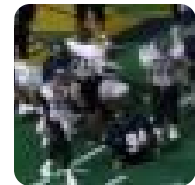

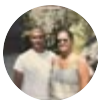
