He will be remembered for his warmth, humor, and the genuine way he cared for others. His family and friends will miss him deeply and love him always.

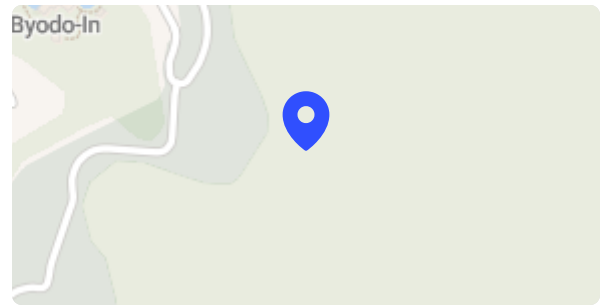

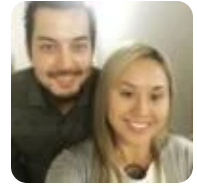
