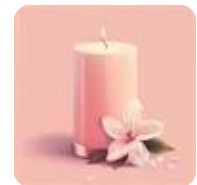
Eunice was held in great affection by her many friends at HonPub. The highlight of our company parties was her performance of a beautiful hula. She was blessed with grace. In loving memory ...
