Margaret was born on October 22, 1920 in Honolulu, HI.

Margaret gained her angel wings on November 4, 2017.

Her parents (preceded in death) were William Ahina Funn & Mary Quintero Funn, and she was the 2nd born of 5 children.

On June 14th, 1941 Margaret married "The Handsome Hawaiian" Joseph Lui (preceded in death) at St. Theresa's Church. They happily lived in Honolulu on the island of O`ahu, until moving to Ewa Beach in 1991.

Margaret was a proud graduate of Farrington High School. Later, she attended Technical Schooling, which led to a rewarding nursing career. After working for over 30 years, Margaret retired in 1977 from the Hawaii State Hospital in Kāne`ohe.
