Nancy L. Wooten, 66, a longtime resident of Mililani, HI, earned her angel wings on June 17, 2020 at her residence in Mililani.

Nancy was born December 8, 1953, in Cuthbert, GA, to Clifford and Mary Ann (Stillson) Wooten.

She graduated from Randolph Southern in Shellman, GA in 1971. She continued her education at Georgia Southwestern in Americus, GA before enlisting in the Army in 1974 where she became a Medical Specialist. She earned the National Defense Service Award, Army Commendation Medal, Good Conduct Medal and Joint Service Medal. After her six-year term of service she moved to Mililani, HI and continued her education at Hawaii Loa College receiving a Master's Degree in Nursing.

Nancy worked as a private special needs Nurse for many years. She was employed with RCM Home Health Agency, Waipahu, HI, for approximately 10 years. She worked with medically fragile special needs children in the department of education at Kainalu Elementary in Kailua, HI. Her coworkers described Nancy as being skillful, caring and loving to all the many children she was responsible for. She dedicated her life to those children and their parents.

Nancy enjoyed traveling the world visiting her lifelong friends as well as traveling with friends around the world. She enjoyed walking and hiking. She recently resumed a hobby she loved, making stained glass pictures.

She was an active member of Pacific Islands Bible Church, Mililani, HI which she attended for more than 30 years.

She is survived by her sister and brothers; Sharon Barrow and her husband Glen of Social Circle, GA; David Wooten of Athens, GA; Steven Wooten and his wife Ruth of Carlton, GA and Michael Wooten and his wife Amy of Cuthbert, GA; and several nieces, nephews, great nieces and great nephews.
